Notice of a Community Governance Review

Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 Local Government (Parish and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008

The Council has commenced a Community Governance Review. The purpose of the review is to enable the Council to consider what changes are needed to the parish arrangements within the District.

A review is needed now to deal with the following specific issues:

- To consult with electors in the Great Brickhill and Soulbury Parishes in relation to the current Parish boundary which runs along Ivy Lane, to the south of Great Brickhill. This will include consulting with areas about whether they should be included within the Great Brickhill or Soulbury Parish. The affected properties are:
 - Clover Hill
 - The Stables
 - Alders Farm
- To consult with electors in the Bierton with Broughton Parish in relation to possible warding arrangements to take account of the Aylesbury East 'Kingsbrook' development.
- Any requests to change the number of councillors on Town and Parish Councils ready for the 2019 elections.
- Any requests for minor alterations to Town and Parish Council boundaries ready for the 2019 elections.

The Council is now conducting the first stage of the review process and is inviting residents and interested organisations to submit their views on the above issues.

The Council has published its Terms of Reference Document for the review and a copy can be obtained by contacting the Electoral Services team as shown below or viewed at the Council's Offices at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury HP19 8FF.
